## **WHAT WE DO**

The Lord's Pantry of Downingtown began in 1965 as a small outreach effort within a local church. Over time it grew to include support for the broader community and now serves families facing food insecurity primarily in Downingtown, Exton, Lionville and Thorndale. As a Choice Pantry, we empower clients to select their own food.

We currently serve over 700 registered households, providing a 14-day supply of food to families in need. We help those who are frequently unable to make ends meet as well as families who need assistance on a short-term basis.

Our work is powered by over 100 dedicated volunteers who generously give their time to staff the pantry, pick up donated food, and assist the people we serve.



## **IF YOU NEED HELP**

You may receive food and supplies, free of cost, if:

- ✓ You live in our primary service area of Downingtown, Lionville, Exton or Thorndale.
- ✓ Your total household income is at or below 185% of the poverty level (as determined by the Federal Government).
- ✓ You are facing a short-term emergency or are temporarily without income.

\*To register for our **Special Programs**, please bring proof of address (lease, bill, etc) and proof of household income.

### **Other Support & Programs**

- ◆ **Emergency Food:** Emergency food is available to anyone in need, regardless of location or registration status.
- ◆ **Special Programs:** Registered clients may qualify for special programs (like holiday meals) and Director's Fund. See our website for details.
- ◆ **Community Referrals:** We can connect you with other agencies for assistance with other essential needs.
